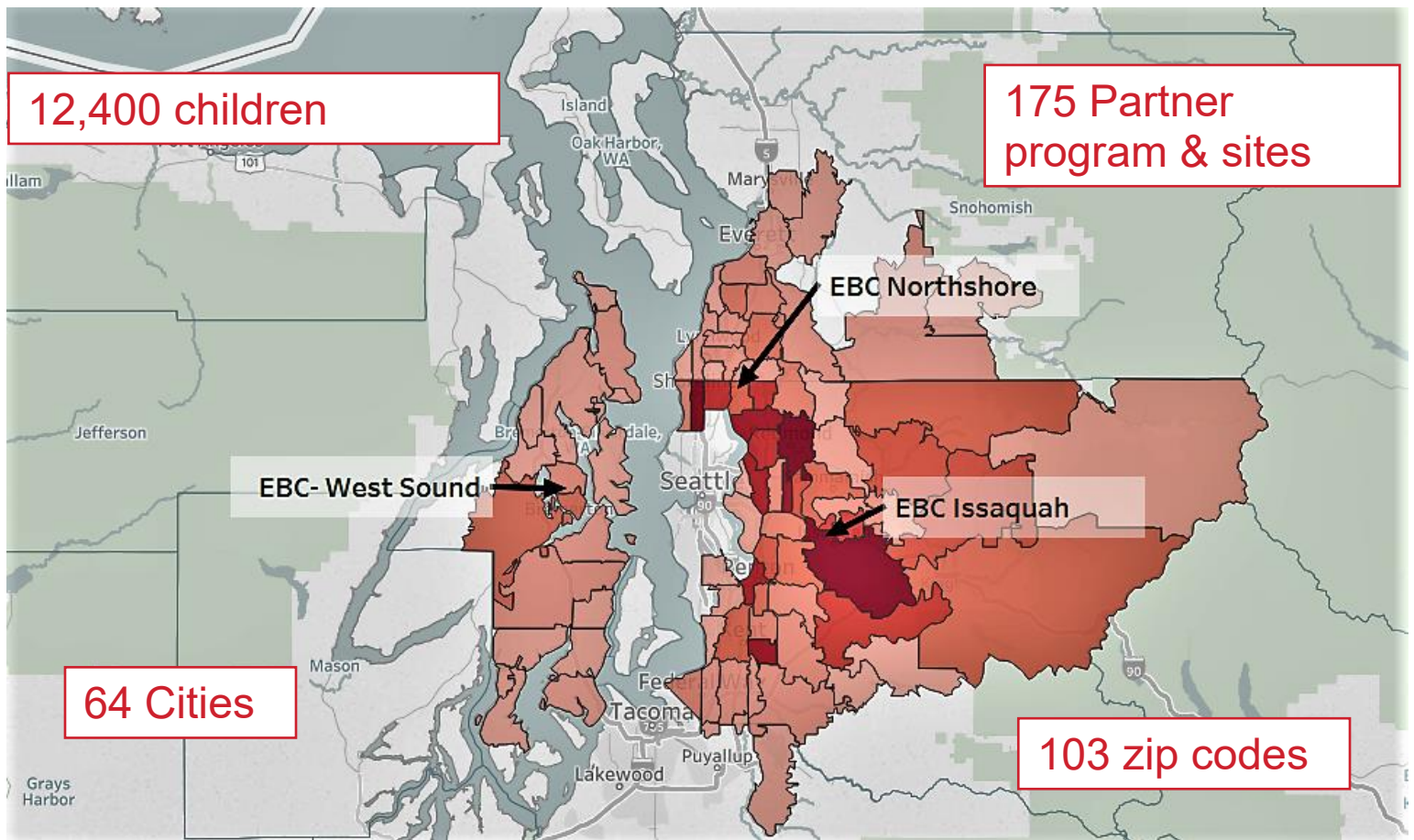

EBC's Role in Your Community

EBC is a non-profit that has been helping kids and families on the Eastside and beyond for 29 years. EBC helps kids aged birth – 12 years through this very simple model: They collect items that parents no longer use (kids clothing, toys, books, baby 'gear', bedding etc.) and give it out, free of charge through service care providers directly to local families in need. Monetary donations are used to purchase essential care items for distribution such as diapers, wipes, formula, pack & play cribs and car seats; and to help meet the administrative costs of running EBC. 2018 EBC provided kids with almost 95,000 orders of clothing, shoes, books, diapers, wipes, car seats, school supplies and much more, valued at \$4,130,520.
